



May 16 2009 Fishers of Men Central Texas Trail head to Austin, TX and Lake Travis for the **Take Down on Travis** and regional qualifier tournament,

We finish up the 2009 season on the beautiful 18,930 acres reservoir nestled in the scenic Texas Hill Country. Not only is this the final event for valuable points in the points championship race, it will also serve as the divisions qualifying tournament (details below).

TOURNAMENT LOCATION:

Jones Brothers Park in Jonestown TX will be the site for the Saturday May 16, 2009 tournament.

19. REGIONAL QUALIFIER TOURNAMENT

The Regional Qualifier Tournament will be the final Tournament within your Division. It will be a 1-day tournament. Entry fees will remain at \$150.00. The top 5 teams in this tournament who have fished in (actually competed in) at least 4 tournaments within that division (including the regional qualifier) and who have not qualified by way of the points system, or by being the highest finishing adult/junior team or the highest finishing male/female team, will qualify for the Regional Championship Tournament. The Regional Qualifier Tournament is open to all teams.

LAKE BELTON DETAILS AND POINTS CHASE:

Kelly Mauldin and Bill Flanary took first place honors with a limit of bass weighing 16.66 pounds, including a 4.08 kicker fish.

Taking second spot and moving them in 7th place year to date is the team of Dale Reed and Paul Carmen, bringing 14.98 pounds to the scales. Making a big move to the top, and currently tied for first place on the Angler of the Year chase is Chad Thiel and Bruce Davis with 14.49 limit of bass.

As the points race comes down to this final event, two teams are tied for first place with 767 points; both teams also represent Texas Boat World. The teams of Ronnie Trower and Jeff Pitruca along with Chad Thiel and Bruce Davis are going to need to bring their A game to Lake Travis.

Holding on to 3rd place is the team of Tim Dixon and Kenneth Cummins with a near 4 points behind with 763 points.

Close behind thin in 4th spot with 760 points is the team of Trey Groce and Bryan Cook

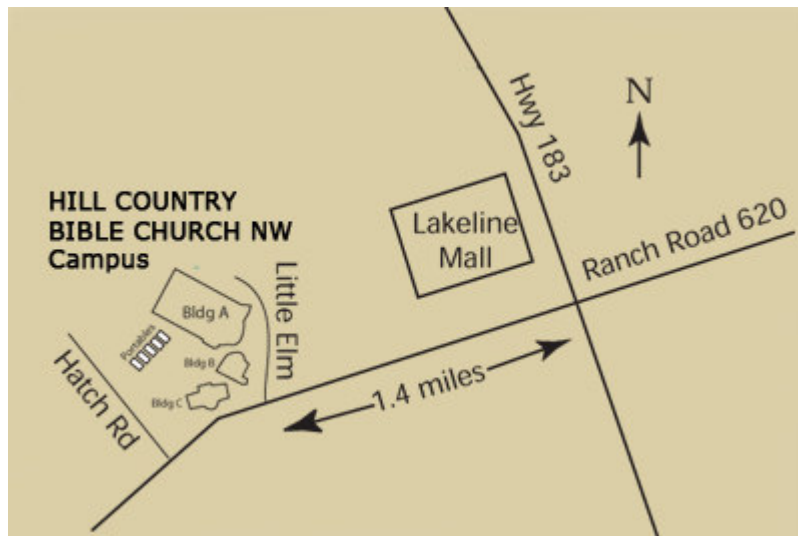
PRE TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:
